The SUBMARINER Network, founded in 2014, is a unique bottom-up platform that brings together actors from the whole Baltic Sea Region to actively promote innovative and sustainable uses of marine resources. With 40 members and 600+ partners from private and public organisations within the Baltic and beyond, it operates across the whole knowledge triangle (education, research, and innovation), by integrating perspectives from local to transnational scale, different science disciplines as well as policy and economic institutions including more and more companies. Based on the results and recommendations of 13+ SUBMARINER projects (since 2014) and through numerous workshops and stakeholder roundtables, we have over the past year updated the first SUBMARINER Roadmap, published in 2014. By assessing the current status of the Baltic Blue Bioeconomy, we show the next steps across all actors, which are necessary to reach its full potential by 2030. Funding programmes as well as Baltic Sea coordinating bodies like yours will of course play a key role here; the more as the SUBMARINER network is a 100% bottom-up financed organisation.
